Coaching Commitments:

Anyone interested in coaching a class 1 team for SCCYPFC must understand and commit completely to the following:

- All coaches must have completed the appropriate coaching license as stipulated by CYSA District II.
- All coaches must attend the mandatory coaches meeting for SCCYPFC during spring and the District II Ambronzo meeting in September.
- All coaches must attend a Positive Coaching Alliance Workshop in association with SCCYPFC.
- All coaches are required to complete two player evaluations throughout the year. One at the end of the fall season and another at the end of State cup or spring.
- All coaches will be evaluated by their players and parents on an annual basis.
- All new uniforms must comply with club colors.
- All coaches are required to support the class I club tournament in whatever manner reasonably requested.
- Coaches must promote team participation on a countywide basis by conducting free and open tryouts for all players.
- During tryouts teams are expected to provide information to the players detailing the level of commitment expected at the class I level. This should include the length of season, number of tournaments, frequency of practice, financial commitments, fundraising requirements, expected behavior of players and parents and the level of physical and mental effort expected in order to achieve success for the team.
- Coaches must commit to a minimum seven-month season, preferably 10 months at the younger age groups. All teams are expected to play in state cup regardless of success in league play.
- Coaches are also expected to promote the class I club by providing opportunities for player and coach community service with lower level soccer teams and athletes.
- All coaches are expected to behave according to the rules and regulation as stipulated by SCCYPFC. Remember this is only a game and it is the player's game. Act with maturity and class at all times. Be the role model you would like our kids to follow.
- All teams will be required to support the leagues fund raising efforts, coaches are expected to promote the successful completion of this task.
- All teams are required to provide at least two volunteers to help the league when requested, coaches must provide a list of those volunteers once team has been selected.

Failure to fulfill any of the commitments above will have an adverse affect on coaching selection the following season.
